Chase the Ace of Hearts is a little bit exciting. We are at **\$1,800**. **This will be on hold** and eagerly awaiting our return when the club re-opens.

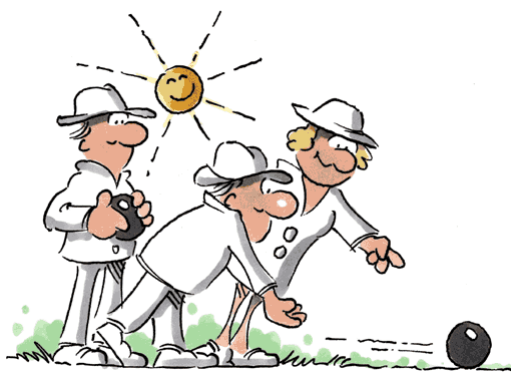


The Members draw here we go.....
