He's part of a unique club where in his debut season in 1944 he won premierships with both the reserves and the league....the grand final win against Jack Dyers Richmond was the last VFL premiership Fitzroy won.

Jarvo himself represented Victoria at junior level and enjoyed a stellar playing and coaching career over many years where he went on and made a significant mark with the armed forces with his physical training regime...being honoured with an OM (Order of Merit) is recognition of this service to country.

For your information: two other club members also served in 7RAR namely Graham Steele and Ross DeGray.
