HALLS HEAD BOWLING CLUB RAISES \$5000 FOR BREAST CANCER NETWORK AUSTRALIA

A Halls Head Bowling Club member has raised more than \$5000 for a breast cancer charity, thanks to some fetching pink shirts.

Gail Nimmo designed pink bowling shirts for club members, with \$5 from the sale of each shirt donated to Breast Cancer Network Australia.

The non-profit group supports people affected by breast cancer with information, treatment and care.

Ms Nimmo has sold about 200 shirts, collecting about \$1000, and they have become so popular members of other bowling clubs from as far away as Geraldton and Exmouth have bought some.

Despite not having a personal connection to breast cancer, Ms Nimmo said everyone knew somebody who had been affected.

“There’s quite a few women within the club (who have had breast cancer), a lot of the men — their wives have had it,” she said.

“Everyone knows somebody with it or has gone through some form of treatment.”

Ms Nimmo also organised a fundraising day at the club on September 18, which about 120 people attended for games of lawn bowls and raising \$4225 for the charity.

She said the total was more than she expected and the day was made more poignant by the attendance of several club members who had survived breast cancer.

“We had raffles, we had a sausage sizzle and people just donated money and things like that, it was good,” she said.

BCNA chief executive Kirsten Pilatti thanked the Halls Head Bowling Club for their “efforts and inspiration”.

Around the Greens

Hello Umpires,
Use of a bowling arm to deliver the jack
 Below comes from BA and is the correct interpretation of the rule. This comes as a follow up question from one of our umpires. The wording of that policy may be changed in the near future to remove doubt.

"If a player commences using a bowling arm they must continue for the remainder of the game with it. If they commence using the arm for delivering the jack, they must then use the arm to deliver their bowls. They could then chose to deliver a jack with their hand in subsequent ends but must continue with the bowling arm to deliver bowls.

Allowing the use of a bowling arm to deliver the jack only, would allow able bodied players - who have difficulty rolling a jack straight, an unfair advantage over their opponent. This could be a decisive advantage, especially in a Singles game. So the answer is 'No' - a player can't use a bowling arm for the sole purpose of delivering the jack."
