# Coaching Corner

THE BIAS

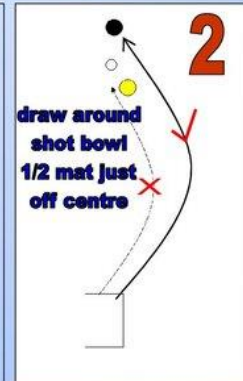


**1** Name: 4 in 20  
 Draw to finish within 1 mat length of the jack.  
*A great warm up exercise and a good guide to your drawing skill.*

OBJECT: To Score 4 shots in the minimum number of bowls and up to a maximum of 20 bowls

Bowl four bowls on same hand and score 1 shot for each bowl within a mat length from the Jack. Repeat for a maximum of 5 ends (20 bowls).

After you score 4 shots or after a maximum of 20 bowls repeat on the other hand.



## PRACTICE WITH PURPOSE

When you head out on the green for a practice session what are you focusing on? What is the objective of your session?

If you don't have a specific objective in mind then you aren't practicing, you're having a roll up! (There is nothing wrong with going out and rolling up with your mates – but don't confuse it with a practice session.)

At every practice session focus on and practice one specific thing that you want to improve in your game.

Practice it with PURPOSE and CONCENTRATION, mentally VISUALISING or rehearsing while you practice and thus experiencing the 'feel' of the delivery in your body. That's how to get the most out of your practice and you will in turn improve your skills.

**2** Skill: Draw behind bowl

Object: To draw around a shot bowl and finish behind the Jack within 1 mat length

4 ends x 4 bowls on forehand to draw around the shot bowl! Under shot bowl does not score. Score if the bowl finishes within 1 Mat of jack. Move 'Shot bowl' in front and to the left of Jack and repeat on backhand

Hint: you can place a mat behind the jack to provide a guide, aim to finish between the jack and the mat.

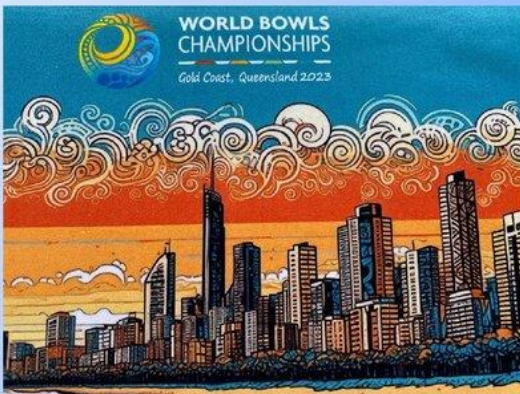
