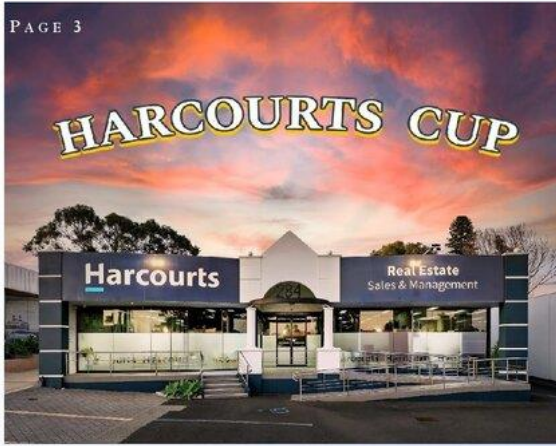

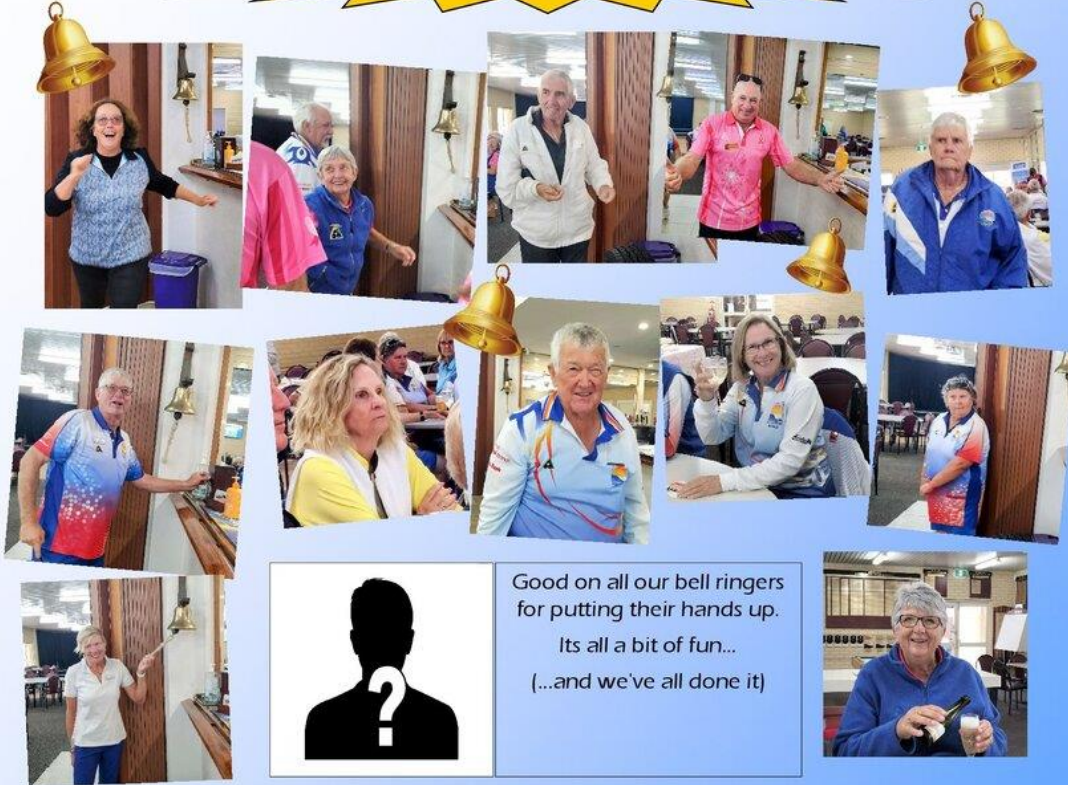
And if anyone out there is prepared to lend us their 00, 0 or size 1 bowls for the morning, please mention that on the volunteers list, which is up on the board.
