Notice of motion to Ladies Half Yearly Meeting 13th November 2023

Motion to be considered at Half Yearly Meeting

I hereby give notice of the following motion;

That the Ladies' Bowls Committee recommends to the Men's Bowls Committee that the number of ends played in the Championship Mixed Pairs return to the previous format, being 12 ends of 2x2x2x2 for all games except the semi-finals and finals. For both semi-finals and finals the number of ends will be 15.

If three games are to be played on the final day then 15 ends will be played in the finals only.

Rationale:

The current format is excessive and doesn't comfortably fit into a day's play. A format that doesn't allow for teams that play out the full number of ends to have a reasonable lunch break, even when called to start at 8.15 in the morning and ending at 6.15 in the evening, will not attract teams to compete.

50 ends of 2x2x2x2 on one day is excessive.

If this is passed then those teams playing three games on Day one will be playing 38 ends (including two trial ends) and those playing three games on day two will be playing 41 ends (including trial ends).
