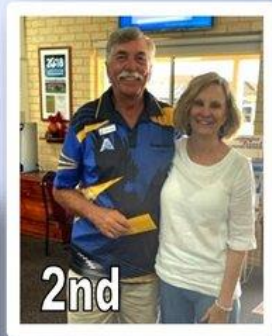

HHBC 2024 AFL TIPPING COMPETITION.

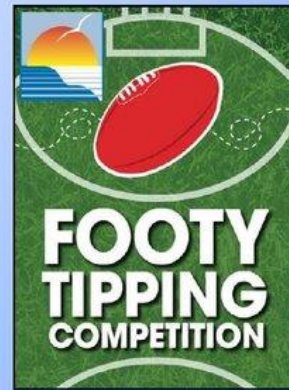
Everyone is welcome, please complete registration form (name and phone number) in the notice board area at the club. Full details of rules and prizemoney are also there.
