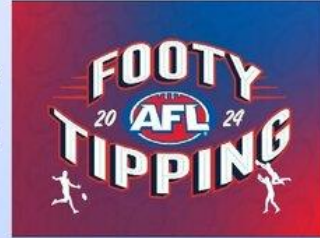
Each round there will be a \$20.00 prize for the winner of the round - this will be paid at the end of season along with the major prizes.
