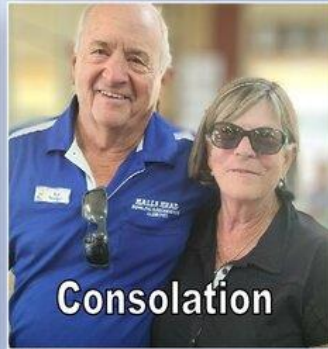
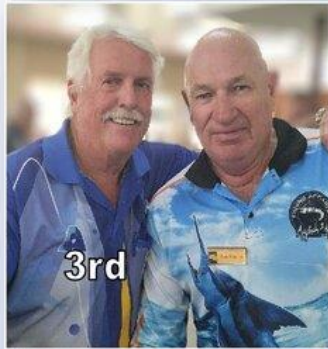
JACK GROVES AND BOB DAY MEDALS

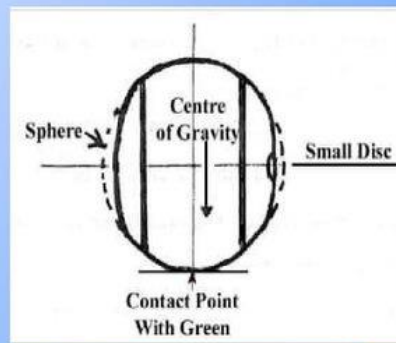

new lawn bowl with adjustable bias

#BREAKING NEWS A new lawn bowl has hit the market, with an adjustable bias for use on all surfaces. You simply adjust the small bias by turning it in or out, either making the bias narrower, or wider to suit green conditions. This will eradicate the need for bowlers to own several sets of bowls. ie: In a two day tournament, day one is fine, you set your bowls on the bias dial (1-10) to suit a 15 second green. Overnight it rains, you reset your set to suit a 12 second green. This will save bowlers owning several sets.
