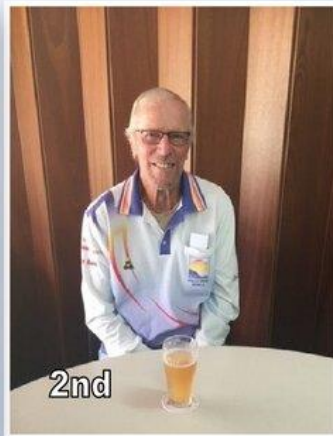

Consolation winner **Allan Shaddick**

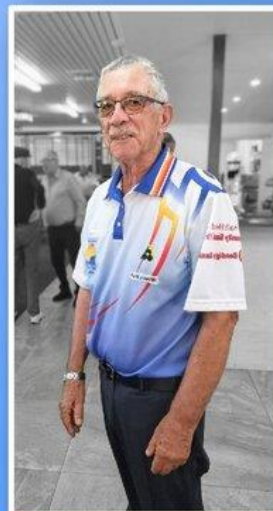
