Bar will be closed Good Friday but open as usual for the rest of Easter.

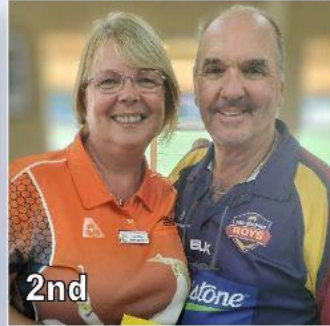

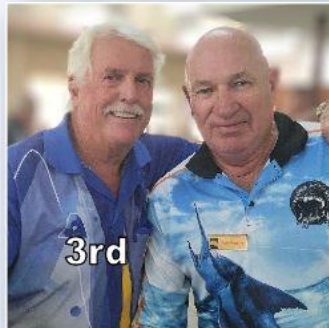
Monday winners

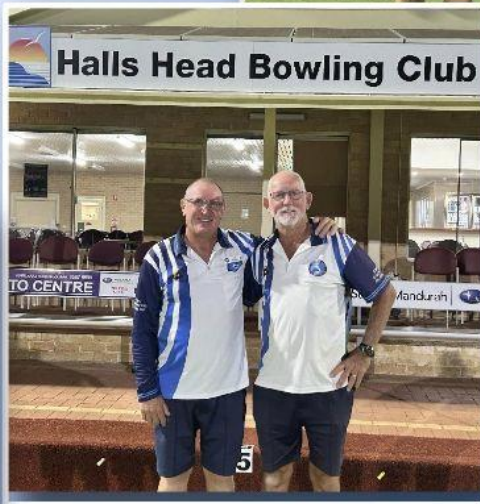
